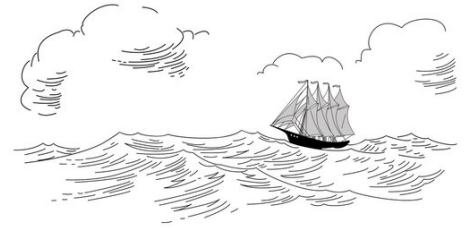


Amazing Grace
