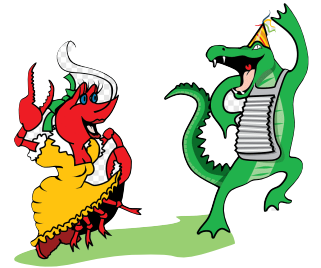


Cajun Baby
